On October 9th we will start unified bowling practice with High Point and Honey Creek at Station 300 on Sunday's. There may also be a unified bowling Special Olympics State Games tournament on November 4 or 5th. Special Olympics has yet to release details about state games. However, we will proceed as if state games are in fact happening so that we have all of the necessary paperwork in on time. Details are below.

1. **Register for the team**

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2. **Complete Medical Forms/Registration for State Games**
Complete the Athlete Registration and Medical Forms (Sports Physical) by Oct 21 electronically at <https://medform.specialolympics.org/instructions?form=0000015f-49d8-d70c-a77f-69dd60ef0000>, or fill out a hard copy and return to the students' High Point classroom teacher. Hard copies will be sent home.
3. **Attend Practice**
Attend at least 3 practice sessions and turn in scores. Practice can be completed during the school day or on Sunday's.

Transportation must be provided by parent/guardian

Unified Partners (Honey Creek students)

Unified Partners attending the competition must complete three steps before Oct 21 to be considered for the team.

1. **Register for the team**

2. **Complete Partner Registration Form**

3. **Practice**
Attend at least 3 practices and turn in your scores to the coach by Oct 30th.
