PARENT INFORMATION / FEEDBACK FORM

The Hearing and Vision Screening Program will be providing hearing and vision screening tests in your child's school.

Early identification of hearing and vision problems is the purpose of the program.

HEARING: Grades scheduled for screening: **Pre-school, Kindergarten, 1st grade, 2nd grade, 4th grade**, special education classes, and parent/teacher requests. Each child is given a preliminary sweepcheck screening by use of an audiometer — a special instrument designed to test hearing. A second, more detailed test is given at a later date for those children about whose hearing there is any question. If your child is found to have a hearing problem, you will receive a letter. There also will be a copy of the technical report to share with your child's physician. Along with this letter there will be an area for your physician to complete. You may also attend one of our Public Health Otology Clinics: there is no charge for this service.

VISION: Grades scheduled for screening: **Preschool, Kindergarten, 1st grade, 3rd grade, 5th grade, 7th grade, 9th grade**, special education classes, Driver's Ed. classes, and parent/teacher requests. Each child is tested for visual acuity, farsightedness, ability to use two eyes together and symptoms of eye problems. A second test is given at a later date for those children about whose vision there is any question. If your child is unable to pass this vision screening, you will receive a letter which has an area for the eye doctor to complete and return to us.
