  - Unanimously passed
- Summer Camp Vaccination Mandate
  - To implement
  - Governance recommends by split vote mandate vaccines for all campers and staff w/o medical excuse
  - CDC recommends vaccination in their summer camp guidance
  - One board member does not like it because he says that after 12 weeks vaccines wane and it doesn't matter any longer (he said it nicer)
  - The Board confirmed that there are a number of summer camps in the area who also require vaccination
  - This is the same requirement as last year
  - Passed by 5 to 1
- Hiring Recommendations
  - Deb Waterman Sp Ed 2 days each week hourly on step 20
  - Angela Niyonsenga Social Worker up to .75 hourly based on step 13
  - Unanimously passed
- Employment referral bonus program
  - Response to Staffing crisis
  - Trying to attract employees
  - Members of the public and staff could get \$500- \$1000 for referring someone who is hired.
    - Paid as a stipend to staff
  - Will remain in effect through September 2024 unless the board acts to amend, extend, or abolish it

- Already discussed with finance committee
- Excludes substitutes
- How many positions? We currently have a special education opening. The rest will depend on the survey that went out to staff today. There are currently 3: SLP, OT, 504 coordinator, social worker, psychologist, all the special education people with openings are on the critical shortage list.
- General Education is not considered critical shortage
- They changed the limit to September 2023 instead of 2024
- They were not thrilled with it they had a lot of issues
- 2023 passed unanimously
- They want data tracked
- The whole Bonus Pilot program as amended
- Unanimously (some with caution)passed
